For I am His and He is mine – Bought with the precious blood of Christ.*

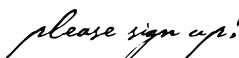


PRAYER REQUESTS

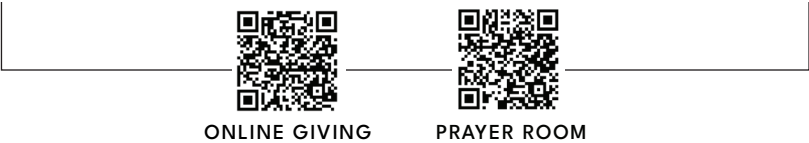
