Ague: recurring fever and/or chills of malarial infection

American Plague: yellow fever

Aphonia: laryngitis

Apoplexy: stroke, or paralysis due to stroke

Bad Blood: syphilis

Bilious Cholic/Fever: bilious pertains to an ailment of the bile or liver resulting in headache, indigestion, nausea, etc. supposed to have been caused by an abnormal liver – likely gall bladder disease or stones

Biliousness: jaundice or other symptoms associated with liver disease

Black Death: plague/bubonic plague

Blood Poisoning: septicemia (bacterial)

Brain Fever: encephalitis, meningitis

Brain Inflammation/Infirmary: likely meningitis

Bright's Disease: kidney inflammation

Camp Fever: typhus

Canine Madness: hydrophobia (fear of water)

Catalepsy: seizures, trances

Catarrhal Fever: related to herpes – symptoms are diarrhea, dark urine, depression

Childbed Fever: see Puerperal Fever

Chlorosis: iron deficiency anemia

Cholera: an acute, infectious, often fatal disease causing diarrhea, vomiting, cramps and dehydration

Cholera Infantum: intestinal disease occurring in warm weather, characterized by pain, vomiting, diarrhea, fever and prostration. an acute intestinal poisoning of bacterial origin starting with severe vomiting and diarrhea, followed by fever, shock, and collapse

Congestion of the Brain: hydrocephalus (build up of cerebrospinal fluid in the brain) – can cause blockage of blood to the body

Congestion of the Liver: retention/pooling of blood in the liver, caused by heart failure – may be the same as or similar to “fatty liver” below – causes liver malfunction

Congestion of the Lungs: pulmonary edema

Congestive Fever: malaria

Consumption: tuberculosis

Corruption: infection

Coryza: a cold

Costiveness: constipation

Coup de Soleil: translates as "stroke/blow of the sun" – sunstroke

Cramp Cholic: appendicitis

Cretinism: hypothyroidism

Croup: viral infection of the airways that spreads to the lungs that can lead to respiratory complications – symptoms include difficulty breathing, raspy cough – common in infants

Cynanche Trachaeitis: cynanche is any inflammatory disease of the throat – cynanche cellularis would mean a sore throat accompanied with excessive cellular growth (hyperplasia) – cynanche is an old term for any acute disease of the throat in which the patient struggles for breath

Debility: debility (feebleness) refers to the state of abnormal bodily weakness

Dropsy: an excessive accumulation of fluids in a cavity or in the subcutaneous cavity – edema (swelling), often caused by kidney or heart disease – congestive heart failure

Dysentery: an infectious disease marked by inflammation and ulceration of the lower part of the bowels and diarrhea

Dyspepsia: deranged/impaired digestion – acid indigestion

Eruption of Vessel: varicose veins

Erycipelas: acute, infectious disease evidenced by a deep red inflammation of the skin

Extravasted Blood: rupture of a blood vessel

Falling Sickness: epilepsy

Fatty Liver: cirrhosis

Female Disease: disease affecting the female reproductive organs, such as endometriosis

Flux: abnormal discharge from the bowels – dysentery – sometimes a lead-in to cholera or diagnosed as cholera

Flus of Humor: circulation

French Pox: venereal disease

Gangrenous Diptheria: gangrene refers to a death of a part due to a lack of blood supply in that area – diptheria is characterized by the formation of a false membrane adhering to the larynx, pharynx, and trachea, although occasionally of the vagina and conjunctiva

Glandular Fever: mononucleosis

Gravel: kidney stones

Green Sickness: anemia

Grippe/La Grippe: influenza

Hip Gout: osteomyelitis

Inflammation of the Bowels: gastritis or gastroenteritis

Influenza: the flu – contagious viral infection of the respiratory tract causing fever, weakness, headache – may lead to pneumonia

Intemperance: alcoholism

Intermittent Fever: recurring fever, malaria

Jail Fever: typhus

Jaundice: also called icterus – symptoms include yellowing of the eyes and skin, vomiting, fever, discolored urine – caused by liver infection or disease

Kings Evil: tubercular infection of the throat lymph glands

Lock Jaw: tetanus

Lues Venera: venereal disease

Lumbago: back pain

Lung Fever: pneumonia

Lung Sickness: tuberculosis

Mania: insanity

Measles: also called rubeola – highly contagious viral illness – symptoms include fever, cough, rash – can lead to encephalitis, bronchitis, pneumonia, excessive bleeding

Milk Sick: consumption of poisoned milk

Mormal: gangrene

Mortification: infection or gangrene of tissue

Neuralgia of the brain: neuralgia is nerve pain, possibly migraine

Nostalia: homesickness

Phthisis Pulmonales: a wasting away of the body – an old term for pulmonary tuberculosis, with subsequent emaciation and loss of strength caused by tuberculosis

Podagra: gout

Potts Disease: tuberculosis of the spinal vertebrae

Prison Fever: see Typhus

Pulmonary Consumption: tuberculosis of the lungs

Puerperal/Childbed Fever: infection of the female reproductive organs following abortion or childbirth – often the result of unhygienic birthing conditions – symptoms include severe abdominal pain – can lead to blood poisoning (septicemia)

Putrid Fever: diphtheria

Putrid Sore Throat: sore throat with a foul smell

Quinsy: tonsillitis

Remittent Fever: a fever that has periods of abatement, but never really goes away – malaria

Sanguinous Crust: scab

Scarlet Fever: highly contagious bacterial infection common in children – symptoms include soar throat, fever, rash

Screws: rheumatism

Scrofula/Scrofula Dysipales/Kings Evil: a form of tuberculosis causing swelling and degeneration of the lymphatic glands especially in the neck and joints

Ship Fever: see Typhus

Smallpox: highly infectious disease similar to chicken pox – symptoms include rash, fever, pustules

Softening of the Brain: cerebral hemorrhage/stroke

Strangery: rupture

St. Vitus Dance: cholera – primarily in children, a bacterial or organic degeneration, irregular of jerky, involuntary muscular movements

Summer Complaint: caused by spoiled food (often milk products), generally affected children, causing severe dehydration and frequently death – food poisoning – baby diarrhea caused by spoiled milk

Suicide by Loderium/Laudinum: Laudinum is a preparation of opium, usually in solution of alcohol it was a liquid opiate used as a cough syrup, pain killer, tonic, and general elixir for whatever ailed you

Typhus/Prison Fever/Ship Fever: also called Rickettsia – infectious disease transmitted by lice – symptoms include fever, depression, delirium, and rash

Ulcerated Bowels: could be ulcerative colitis or infectious colitis characterized by bloody diarrhea

Variola: smallpox

Venesection: bleeding

Whooping Cough: also called pertussis – highly contagious bacterial infection of the respiratory system – usually found in children

Winter Fever: pneumonia

Yellow Fever: viral disease transmitted by mosquitos – symptoms include fever, vomiting, jaundice, abdominal pain, severe bleeding from eyes, mouth, etc., no urine production
